Accordingly, our report relates solely to the income and expenditure account prepared from transactions that have been recorded in the Centre's books and records.

Our engagement included carrying out limited procedures for obtaining sufficient appropriate evidence to be able to draw a conclusion, such as inquires primarily of persons responsible for financial and accounting matters and other procedures we considered necessary.
